



YOUR GIFT. SAM'S FUTURE.

Every day, Sam walked for two hours. It was a mile each way from the shelter to the outreach center where he received case management. On one very hot afternoon Sam stopped to rest, passed out, and woke up at Grady Hospital. There, he learned that homelessness was taking its toll on his body—all the walking, heat, and stress were making his arthritis so severe he could barely move. On top of that, his diabetes and HIV were out of control. He was terrified to discover that without skilled nursing, his left foot would need to be amputated within a year.

Sam's doctor recommended Living Room's recuperative care program when Sam was ready for discharge from Grady. Sam agreed, desperately wanting to improve his health and living situation. While healing, he worked with his case manager to complete an application for permanent supportive housing. Sam qualified for Legacy Care Home, and now only takes short, pleasant walks for his health. At his last check-up, he learned that his leg is healing well, and he is hopeful for the first time in many years.
