GEORGIA'S HIV/AIDS EPIDEMIC

Even as HIV/AIDS treatment and prevention improve, Georgia continues to see an increase in new infections. Across Georgia, more than 50,000 people are living with diagnosed HIV/AIDS, and almost 30,000 of those live in metro Atlanta. In February 2016, a report by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention listed Georgia as having the third highest rate of new HIV infections in the nation.
